To request the RI Board to consider that terminated clubs secure endorsement from the district

- 1 WHEREAS, a terminated club may be reinstated as a member of RI upon
- 2 payment of fees and charges, and

- 4 WHEREAS, causes for termination may not be limited to non-payment of fees,
- 5 but may also include other untoward acts and activities inimical to RI, and

6 7 WHEREAS, the district concerned should ensure the rectification of acts

- 8 unbecoming a Rotarian and should seek a resolution from the club to refrain
- 9 from and avoid the repetition of such acts
- 10
- 11 IT IS RESOLVED by Rotary International that the Board of Directors of Rotary
- 12 International consider requiring that terminated clubs secure clearance and
- 13 endorsement from the district, as well as attend a basic orientation session, to be
- 14 conducted and/or recommended by the district.

PURPOSE AND EFFECT

- 15 This resolution proposes to unify the vision of each club and to ensure the
- 16 preservation of integrity, unquestionable reputation, and genuine humanitarian
- 17 efforts of RI through a stringent screening process of errant but remorseful
- 18 Rotarians.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

- 19 If implemented, this resolution would have no substantial financial impact on RI.
- 20 Currently, clubs can only be reinstated if they are terminated due to unpaid dues
- or other financial obligation to RI or approved contributions to the district fund.
