We would like to thank all of the Rotarians in District 3462 who have participated in Rotary Youth Exchange and contributed to this outstanding program. RI staff reviewed the certification documents submitted by the district, and based on the information provided, we are pleased to notify you that District 3462 has met the minimum requirements for certification of its Youth Exchange program as set by the RI Board of Directors.

District 3462's current certification is contingent upon continued adherence to all RI policies for any long-term and short-term exchanges, as well as the annual submission of a certification renewal form and inbound student data (including the names and contact information for long-term students' second and third host families). All certified districts will be asked to recertify again on a staggered basis of every five to seven years.
